

Extra school activities

As usual we have a wide choice of after school activities to keep your child busy after school. Some are organized by IPS staff, some by parents and some by specialists who come into IPS. As with all after school activities, parents should ensure that their children are collected at the end of the activity and, where appropriate, the office is informed that children will not be using school transport.

Overleaf is a provisional schedule of activities – other activities might be added to this list if there is an interest from either children, teachers or for that matter, parents! Or if in the opposite case we do not have enough interest then the activity will have to be cancelled. On the last page you will find some activities for which no particular time is scheduled, either because they are on a one to one basis, or where the time will be decided after the teacher knows who is interested.

IMPORTANT safety note for ALL parents:

Please collect children promptly at 3.00 or 3.30. After 4 p.m. there is no supervision in the playground, so any child not collected by 4 p.m. (and not in an after school activity) will be taken to the Homework Club, for which you will be charged.

Unless otherwise advised after school clubs **will start the second full week (Monday 17th September)**.

Please note:

Although activities take place at IPS and are organised through the school office, ALL activities are privately run by the member of staff concerned, and payment should be made directly to them. IPS is unable to issue invoices for after school activities.

Registrations for after school clubs can be made through the school office as from **Monday 10th September**. If you are unable to come to school then it is possible to send an e-mail over the weekend. But please note that in order to give everybody an opportunity to enrol **e-mails will only be accepted as from 4 p.m. on SUNDAY AFTERNOON anything sent before will not be opened.** **BUT** also please note that there are many, many activities and most of them do not get filled up, so **do not think that you need to send an e-mail exactly at 4p.m. on Sunday!** The main activities which *tend* to have a waiting list are Gymnastics and Jungle Gym,
